






FAMIS

FAMIS is Virginia's health insurance program for uninsured children. **FAMIS** Plus is Virginia's name for children's Medicaid. Both cover all the medical care growing children need to avoid getting sick, plus the medical care that will help them if they do get sick or get hurt.







COST TO FAMILY

There are no enrollment costs or monthly premiums. With **FAMIS** most co-payments are just \$2.00 or \$5.00. Some services, like regular check-ups, are free. With **FAMIS** Plus, there are no co-payments for any health service.

ELIGIBILITY

Children may be eligible for FAMIS or FAMIS Plus if they:

- · Live in Virginia
- Are under age 19
- Are U.S. citizens or legally-residing immigrants
- Live in families meeting FAMIS income guidelines (For FAMIS only, children must also be currently uninsured)

FAMIS MOMS

FAMIS MOMS and Medicaid for pregnant women provide complete health care including dental coverage for women when they are expecting a baby. Good health care during pregnancy is important for you and your baby. Getting early and regular prenatal care increases the likelihood for a healthy birth outcome.

ELIGIBILITY

To be eligible for FAMIS MOMS or Medicaid for pregnant women you should:

- Be pregnant or be within the sixty-day period after your pregnancy ends
- Be a resident of Virginia
- · Be a U.S. citizen or a qualified legal immigrant
- Currently be uninsured (For FAMIS MOMS only)
- · Meet family income guidelines

Women not eligible for FAMIS MOMS or Medicaid for pregnant women, may be eligible for Emergency Services Medicaid for delivery services only.



BENEFITS

FAMIS MOMS and Medicaid for pregnant women cover maternity and childbirth services. They provide complete health care coverage during pregnancy and through the 60 day period following the end of the pregnancy. FAMIS MOMS and Medicaid also have special services for women with high risk pregnancies.

And just like FAMIS, with FAMIS MOMS there are no enrollment fees or monthly premiums and there are no co-pays for pregnancy related services.

HOW TO APPLY

Women can apply for FAMIS MOMS and Medicaid the same way that families currently can apply for FAMIS for their children. Applying is easy:

- I. A woman can apply online at www.coverva.org. OR
- 2. A woman can apply by calling toll-free 1-855-242-8282 anytime between 8 am and 7 pm, Monday through Friday or 9 am to 12 noon on Saturday. Interpreters are available in most languages. The hearing impaired can call the TTY line at 1-888-221-1590. OR
- 3. A woman can apply at her local Department of Social Services.
